All three rings will be run CONCURRENTLY

PLEASE SEE RUNNING ORDER BELOW!! THE RUNNING ORDER CHANGES DAILY!

RESULTS:

Because of the significant number of runs and a changing venue, NCR copies of scribe sheets will NOT be available at this trial, except for the FAST classes. Results will be displayed on monitors in a designated area. Additionally, there will be two computers available to look-up all results by armband number. As always, you should view and confirm your results of your runs as quickly as possible. Any discrepancies can be viewed and resolved with the score table and/or judge if identified early. Final results will be posted as quickly as available.

CONFLICTS:

Because this trial is held concurrently with a number of other venues, as well as three agility rings, we are asking you to handle conflicts in the following manner. Please Check-in every morning for EVERY CLASS. There will be boards posted with all the Gate Sheets for that day. If you need to separate multiple dogs within the same class and height, you may do so as long as you don't change the order of the dogs. Otherwise, only handlers with genuine conflicts will be allowed to move their dogs in the running order. If you anticipate a conflict in ANY class, you MUST mark your name with a "C". If your conflict is only with your walkthrough please try to walk with an earlier group. You must have permission from the Secretary, Chair, or Gate Steward to move a dog to ANOTHER jump height. If you do have a height conflict, it would be preferable for you to run in an earlier jump height. This allows the score table to close out classes. You may only move your dog in the order IF you have a legitimate conflict. Separating multiple dogs is allowed only if you keep them in the original order and, if possible, move the first dog up in the order. Exhibitors are solely responsible for having their dog at the ring when it is their turn to run. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Be at the gate at least 4 dogs before your turn to go.

WALK-THRUS:

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE GIVEN DURING THE JUDGE'S BRIEFING.

B will run before A, followed by Preferred within each height group as designated above, except as noted for Excellent 20".

Excellent A 20", Excellent A 20" Preferred and Excellent B Preferred 20" will run with the 24-26" Height Group all days.

All exhibitors will be allowed to walk the course, without dogs, before the start of their class. Due to the size of certain walk-thru groups, additional splits in the walk-thru groups may occur. Please arrive early enough to participate in your scheduled group if this occurs.

AKC MEASUREMENTS

The check-in process will be self check-in for those who have a valid height card. The notebooks with armband(s) will be filed alphabetically under handler names with each day's armbands. If you need to be measured, your armband(s) will be with the Trial Secretary. There will be measurement forms at check-in to give to the VMO for measurement. Please have your information handy and complete the form before being measured.

MOVE-UPS:

Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date of February 2, 2011. E-mail request for a move up is acceptable with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either a move up form or an e-mail must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00p.m. February 14, 2011. Move-up entries for Saturday, Sunday or Monday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site within **20 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from** and the exhibitor MUST be entered on the day the form was completed.

VOLUNTEERS

HOSPITALITY

In an effort to go green, we will not be providing bottled water at the hospitality table. Instead, we will be providing water in large coolers. Please bring a water bottle to take advantage of this.

COMMON COURTESIES

Leash laws will be enforced; all dogs must be on lead or confined to crates or x-pens when not being judged, except when in the designated warm-up area. Please clean up after your dog. Anyone observed not clean up after your dog, or allowing their dog run off-lead, will be asked to leave the trial site for the remainder of the weekend. No refunds! Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.

CRATING

There will be NO public set-up of crates until Thursday, February 17th. Crate set-up will be on Thursday, February 17th from 10:00am to 5:00pm. The crating area inside the building will be limited. Mats will be allowed under EX-pens or crates only. The use of ex-pens may be restricted based on the size and number of dogs accommodated. Please be considerate and place crates close together to accommodate as many as possible. In the concrete area, please limit your items as much as possible & consolidate your equipment. The show committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes.

PARKING REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense. Parking in front of building is limited to those with handicapped permits and unloading only.

GATE 7 will be designated as entrance only from 6:00 AM to 10:00 AM with a dedicated lane for unloading (Friday through Sunday). Please have your Parking Pass displayed as you pull in to the grounds.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. DIRECTIONS FROM THE SHOW TO ANIMAL CRITICAL CARE & EMERGENCY SERVICES: West on I-70 to Wadsworth, go South on Wadsworth past 20th Ave to Animal Critical Care & Emergency Services, located on the right side of the road.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL: PLEASE NOTE – Traffic on I-70 Friday and Monday mornings can be very heavy so please plan accordingly. There will be no delay of trial for heavy traffic.

FROM EAST OR WEST - Take Interstate 70 to Brighton Blvd. exit 275B. Upper deck is I-70. Ground level is E. 48th Ave. Go North on Brighton Blvd. past Event Center to Gate 7.

FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH - Take Interstate 25 to exit 214A (Junction with I-70) then east 1 mile to exit 275B.
